SCHEME OF POST-MATRIC SCHOLARSHIP FOR STUDENTS BELONGING TO THE MINORITY COMMUNITIES

Good news for minority students pursuing higher education, from class XI upto Ph. D. and technical and vocational courses of class XI and XII level.

Applications are invited from the students belonging to the minority communities notified by the Central Government, pursuing higher education, from class XI upto Ph. D. and technical and vocational courses of Industrial Training Institutes/Industrial Training Centres (affiliated with NCVT) in government schools/institutes or schools/colleges/institutes recognized by the appropriate authority for post-matric scholarship to be awarded by the Ministry of minority Affairs, Government of India. Application in the prescribed format which can be downloaded from the official website of MOBC department viz <http://manipur.nic.in/mobc.htm> should be submitted along with requisite documents to the Director, Directorate of Minorities and Other Backward Classes, Government of Manipur, Babupara, Imphal. The last date for receipt of application is **31st January, 2008.**

Object:

The objective of the scheme is to award scholarship to the meritorious students belonging to economically weaker sections of minority communities to enable them to pursue higher education from class XI to Ph. D. and technical and vocational courses of class XI and XII level for enhancing their employability.

Scope:

The scholarship is to be awarded for studies in India only.

Conditions for scholarship:

- (a) Scholarship will be given to the students, pursuing studies from class XI to Ph. D. from Government/recognized private school/college/institute including technical and vocational courses of class XI and XII level in Industrial Training Institutes/centres affiliated with the National Council for Vocational Training, The amount of scholarships will be the actual of Admission and tuition/course fee subject to a maximum ceiling limit of Rs 3,000 to Rs.10,000 per annum. Maintenance allowance @ Rs 2350 to Rs 5100 per annum for Hostellers and Rs 1400 to Rs 3300 for Day scholars will also be given as admissible as per the scheme guidelines which may be seen in the official websites.
- (b) Maintenance allowance will be credited to the student's bank account.
- (c) To be eligible, students should have not less than 50% marks in the previous final examination. Students from BPL families, having the lowest income shall be given preference in the ascending order.
- (d) Scholarship holder under the scheme will not avail of any other scholarship/stipend for pursuing the same course.
- (e) The annual income, from all sources of the student's parents or guardians should not exceed Rs. 2.00 lakhs.
- (f) 30% of scholarship will be earmarked for girl students. In case girl students are not available then the scholarship earmarked for them will be awarded to eligible boy students.
- (g) Scholarships will not be given to more than two students in a family.
